

**Will of William Nunn of Lawshall, Suffolk, collarmaker**

Paraphrased transcription

- To wife Susan: all movables that were hers before marriage
- To wife Susan and son William, to sell all lands and tenements in Lawshall, and all goods and chattels. Proceeds to be equally divided between:
  - Susan my wife (plus £5 for executing will)
  - William my son
  - Christian my daughter
  - Thomas my son
  - Sarah my daughter
  - Robert my youngest son

Executors: the abovementioned Susan and William

20 March 1670/1

Witnesses: Edward Cracke, John Wright

Proved: 15<sup>th</sup> April 1671
