### **Memorandum 1720**

The Reverend Mr Thos Baker A.M. succeeded Mr Rathborne in this Living, but never resided here at all.

### **Memorandum 1723**

Tristram Evans A.M. succeeded Mr Baker and was inducted ye twenty second day of June 1723: on ye 23 October 1727 he came here to reside: He had then 2 children, ye oldest whereof.

-Francis was born ye 10<sup>th</sup> day of February 1724/5 at Epsom in County of Surry & is there register'd.

- Charles was born ye 11 day of August 1726 at Fineshade Abbey in ye County of Northampton & is registered at Dodington a village within 4 miles of Stamford Lincolnshire.

### **June 20<sup>th</sup> 1731**

#### **Memorandum**

Whereas sometime in this month ye surveyors erected a post upon ye causeway near ye Parsonage, in memory of Mr Rathborne's having made it at his own charge; it is to be noted, that this cannot be an Obligation upon any succeeding Incumbent to make mend or Repair that parcel of Road; it being a voluntary Act in Mr Rathborne as a small Confaction? to the Parish as was Lord Guildfords causeway adjoining.
