

Examination: Golding Quilter, 18 March 1818

Essex. The Examination of Golding Quilter now residing in the parish of Kirby in the said County Blacksmith touching the place of her last legal settlement Taken on Oath the 18th day of March 1818.

Who Saith that he was born in the parish of Kirby aforesd where his parents belonged as he has heard and believes. That he served his apprenticeship in Kirby to his Brother Edward Quilter. That upwards of 40 yrs ago he hired a Messuage Shop premes. in Thorpe parish where he resided about 4 yrs and paid rates to the poor, That he so resided in Thorpe under a Certificate from the parish of Kirby. That on Quitting his residence at Thorpe he hired a House shop and premises in St Osyth parish where he resided about 13 yrs, at a Rent of £8 p ann. ? the poor rates. That he so resided in St Osyth under a certificate from Kirby. That he has ever since worked as a journeyman and has done no other Act whereby he has gained a Settlement . That he has one child unmarried named Elizabeth now about 38 yrs of age.
