

Examination: John Field, 12th June 1805

The Examination of John Field now in the parish of Great Bromley in the said County touching the place of his legal settlement taken upon Oath the 12th day of June 1805.

Who saith he was born in the parish of Mendlesham in the County of Suffolk where his father resided and belonged as he has heard and believes

That five years ago last Michaelmas he let himself to Mr Saml. Cooper of All Saints parish in the Borough of Colchester in the said County for a year at the wages of nine pounds and fourteen shillings that he duly served the said year and received his full wages

That he afterwards let himself to the said Mr Cooper for another year at the wages of Ten pounds and ten shillings that he duly served? the said year and received his full wages

That he has never done any other Act to gain a Subsequent Settlement

That he has a wife living named Mary and one Child named George aged one year and an half
