And that about sixteen years ago he was lawfully married in the parish Church of Saint Osyth in the County aforesaid to Ann Maxfield singlewoman by whom he hath six Children living namely, Mary aged fourteen years or thereabouts, John aged twelve years or thereabouts, Elizabeth aged ten years or thereabouts, William aged Eight years or thereabouts, George aged six years or thereabouts and James aged two years or thereabouts,

And that he hath done no other act wt.soever to the best of his knowl. whereby to gain a legal settlement.
