

Examination: Robert Button, 11 April 1760.

Robert Button of Kirby in the County of Essex Butcher being sworn on his Examination saith That he was an Apprentice to Mr. Wm Bloss of Woodbridge in the County of Suffolk Butcher and served two years out of 5 years of his time and then bought his time out of his Master, and after that he let himself as a yearly Servant to Wm Turpin Butcher in Great Oakley in the County of Essex at nine pounds a year and duly served him one year and reced. his Wages – which said William Turpin keeps a Butchers Shop in Kirby aforesaid where this Deponent served the said William Turpin.

And the said William Turpin during the said year which he served him hired him a lodging (separate from the Shop) where he lodged during the said year.

And this Deponent saith he hath done no Act to gain legal place of Settlement than as above to the best of his Knowledge or Belief.
