

## **Will of Sarah Cardinall of Colchester, widow, 1689**

- To son Charles Cardynall: houses & lands, copyhold and freehold. If he dies under 21 without issue, to her brother Robert Mason of Dedham, clothier.
- To brother Robert Mason: £10
- To sister Elizabeth Mason of Dedham, spinster: £10
- To sister Hannah Mason of Dedham, spinster: £10
- To sister Dorothy Mason of Dedham, spinster: £10
- To her two kinsmen Samuel Webb and Nathaniel Webb of Dedham: £5 each
- To the children of her brother John Peacock: £10 to be divided between them
- To her servant John Tarsell: £10
- Personal estate: to son Charles. If he dies under 21 without issue, to be divided between her five sisters:
  - Mary wife of Samuel Webb
  - Martha wife of John Peacock
  - Elizabeth Mason
  - Hannah Mason
  - Dorothy Mason

Executor: her brother Robert Mason
