To the Church-Wardens and Overseers of the Poor of the Parish of St Osyth in the County of Essex or to any, or either of them.

We whose Hands and Seals are hereunto set, being the Church-Wardens and Overseers of the Poor of the Parish of Kirby in the County of Essex aforesaid, do hereby certify, own and acknowledge Golding Quilter (Blacksmith), Sarah his wife and Sarah their child to be our Inhabitants legally settled in the Parish of Kirby aforesaid. In Witness whereof, we have hereunto set our Hands and Seals this 20th February 1780.
