

**Will of Thomas Newcomb of Tendring, innkeeper, 1848**

This is the last Will and Testament of Thomas Newcomb of Tendring in the County of Essex Inn Keeper made this Seventh day of Febury 1848 as follows that is to say

I do hereby nominate and appoint my beloved wife Sarah sole executrix off this my Last Will and Testament.

I give and devise unto my beloved wife Sarah all my ready money and also all such sum or sums of money as at the time of my decease may be due and owing to me from all and every person and persons whomsoever.

I give and bequeath unto my wife Sarah all my household goods and furniture plate linen china books and other household effects whatsoever as shall be my property at the time of my death.

I publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament In witness where of I the said testator Thomas Newcomb set my hand the day and year first above writting.

The Testator died in the Parish of Tendring on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of April 1848.
