- To son Henry Nunn: a brass pot
- To son Ambrose Nunn: certain furniture
- To daughter Frances Griggs: certain furniture and household goods
- To grandchild Joshua Nunn: the great Bible
- To grandchild Elizabeth Ray: a piece of furniture
- To grandchild Marian Friend: 5 shillings
- To Sarah Ray: 5 shillings
- To grandchild Frances Ray: certain furniture
- To grandchild Frances Hunt: certain household goods
- To grandchild Audrey Hunt: 5 shillings
- To each child of my daughter Griggs: 5 shillings
- To grandchild Mary Ray: 5 shillings
- Rest and residue of my goods and chattels to my daughter Marian Raye on condition she pay my debts and funeral expenses. She to be executrix, assisted by John Frost of Duffton Hall, gent.
