

Will of Robert Nunn of Broadgates, Wkepstead, yeoman, 1675

- To son Thomas: £80
- To son Walter: £60 when 21
- To son Henry: £60 when 21, and £10 to be bound as an apprentice
- To wife Margaret: £5, and all good and chattels in my current dwelling house at the time of my decease, which were hers before our marriage
- To son Robert: all my freehold and copyhold land and tenements in Wkepstead, he to pay my debts and legacies. If Robert refuses to be my executor, then my son Thomas to be my executor and to sell all my copyhold and freehold (the proceeds to be divided between my sons Thomas, Walter and Henry).

Written: 3rd November 1675
