

**Will of Robert Nunne at the Clock, Wkepstead, yeoman, 1679**

- To wife Dorothy: two closes and a grove for her natural life, then to my son Robert Nunne.
- To son Robert Nunne: all my land and tenements after my wife's death, on condition that he pays the following legacies to my daughters after my wife's death:
  - To daughter Frances: £30 within one year of my wife's death
  - To daughter Marrian: £30 within two years of my wife's death
  - To daughter Marible: £20 within three years of my wife's death
- To son Robert: various furniture and household goods (to be used by Dorothy during her lifetime)
- To wife Dorothy: all my goods and chattels for the paying of my debts and the raising of my children.

Executrix: my wife Dorothy Nunne
