

Will of Thomas Parrish of Langenhoe, yeoman, 1679

- To wife Mary: freehold in Langenhoe for her natural life.
 - After her decease to my daughter Mary Fisher, for her natural life, on the condition that Cornelius Fisher, husband of Mary, discharges two bonds in which I stand engaged with him (to Mr. Thomas Grey of Colchester and Widow Thurgood of Higham, Suffolk)
 - After Mary Fisher's death, to my grandchild Parrish Fisher, on the condition that he pays £100 to his sister Mary Fisher after their mother's death.
- To my grandchild Elizabeth Parrish: £100 when she reaches 21.
- To my kinsman Richard Taylor: 40 shillings
- To my two other kinsmen Roger Taylor and John Taylor: 20 shillings each
- To James Parrish, my brother's son: 40 shillings
- Rest and residue to my wife Mary, she to be executrix, supervised by John Fisher, my son-in-law (he to receive £5 for his trouble).
