

**Will of William Gilbert Wade late of Abberton, Essex, wheelwright, now residing at Colchester**

- To be buried in Fingringhoe
- To nephew Thomas Lewis Stone:
  - freehold tenements in Wix occupied by Benjamin Hunt and Bridget Angier
  - copyhold tenement in Wix occupied by John Bird
- To niece Susannah Stone copyhold in Little Clacton occupied by William Starling and others.
- To nephew Frederick Hicks: £200 when 21. Executors can advance up to half of this before Frederick reaches 21 in order to apprentice him or otherwise advance him in the world. Such advances made in the lifetime of Frederick's mother (Ann, the testator's sister – surname not given in the will) to be made with her consent.
  - If Frederick dies before he reaches the age of 21, the remainder of the £200 to the testator's sister, Susannah Stone.
- Rest and residue to Isaac Brett the younger of Inworth, Essex, gardener (the testator's brother-in-law)
- Executors: the said Isaac Brett and the testator's brother-in-law Thomas Lewis Stone
